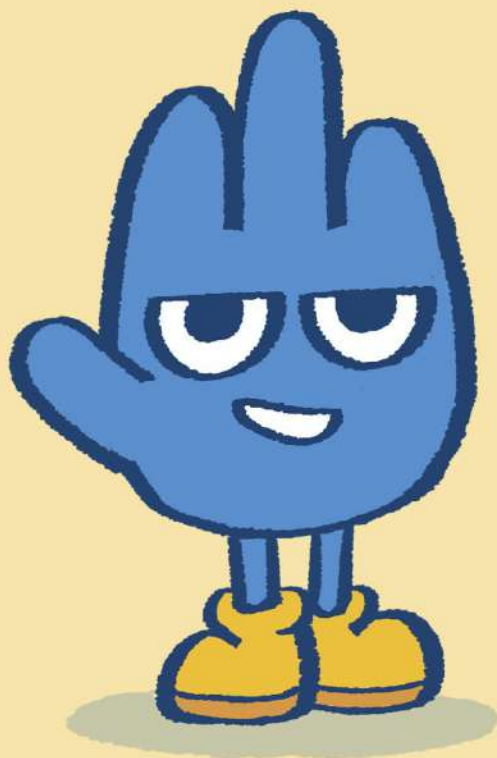

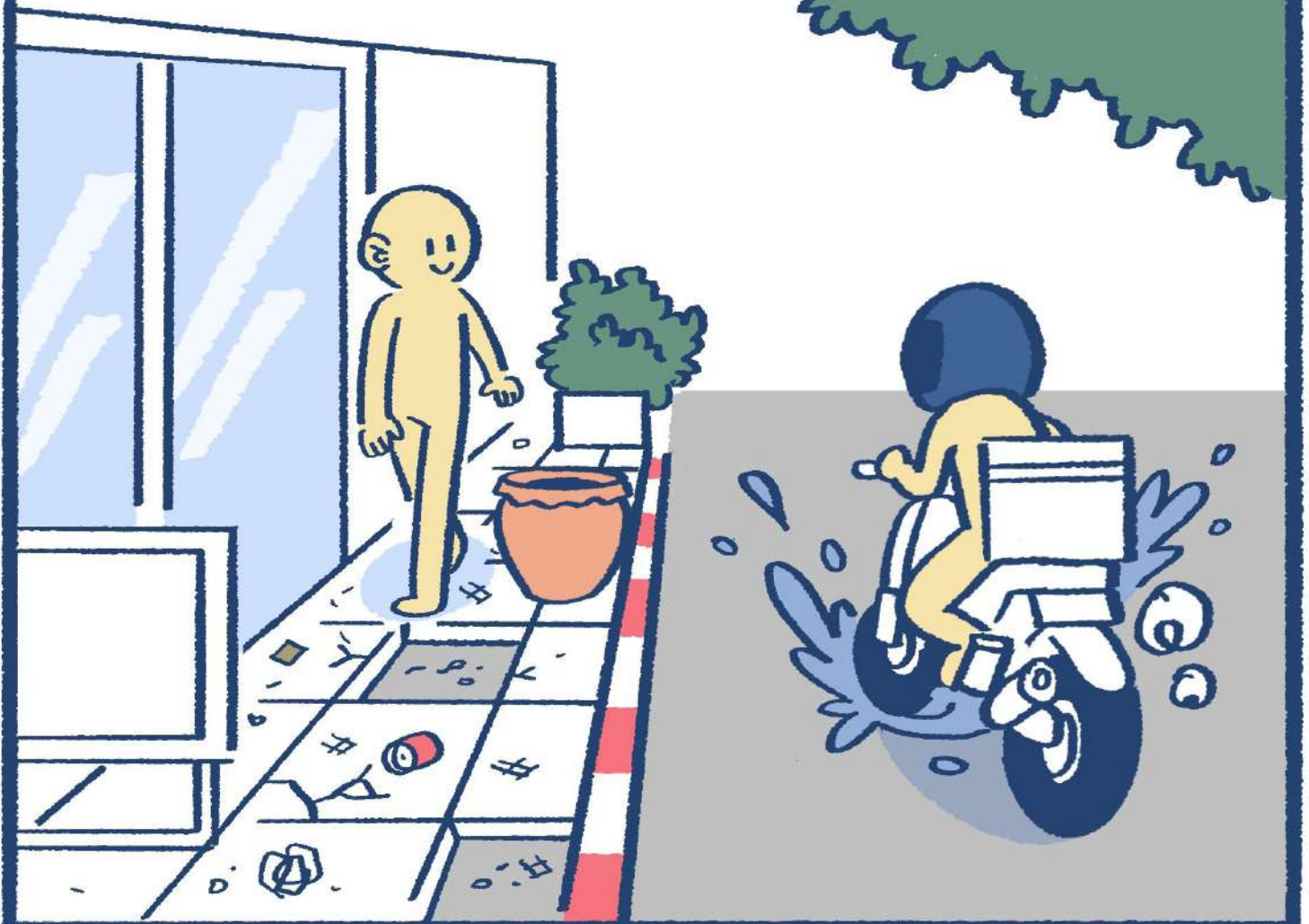

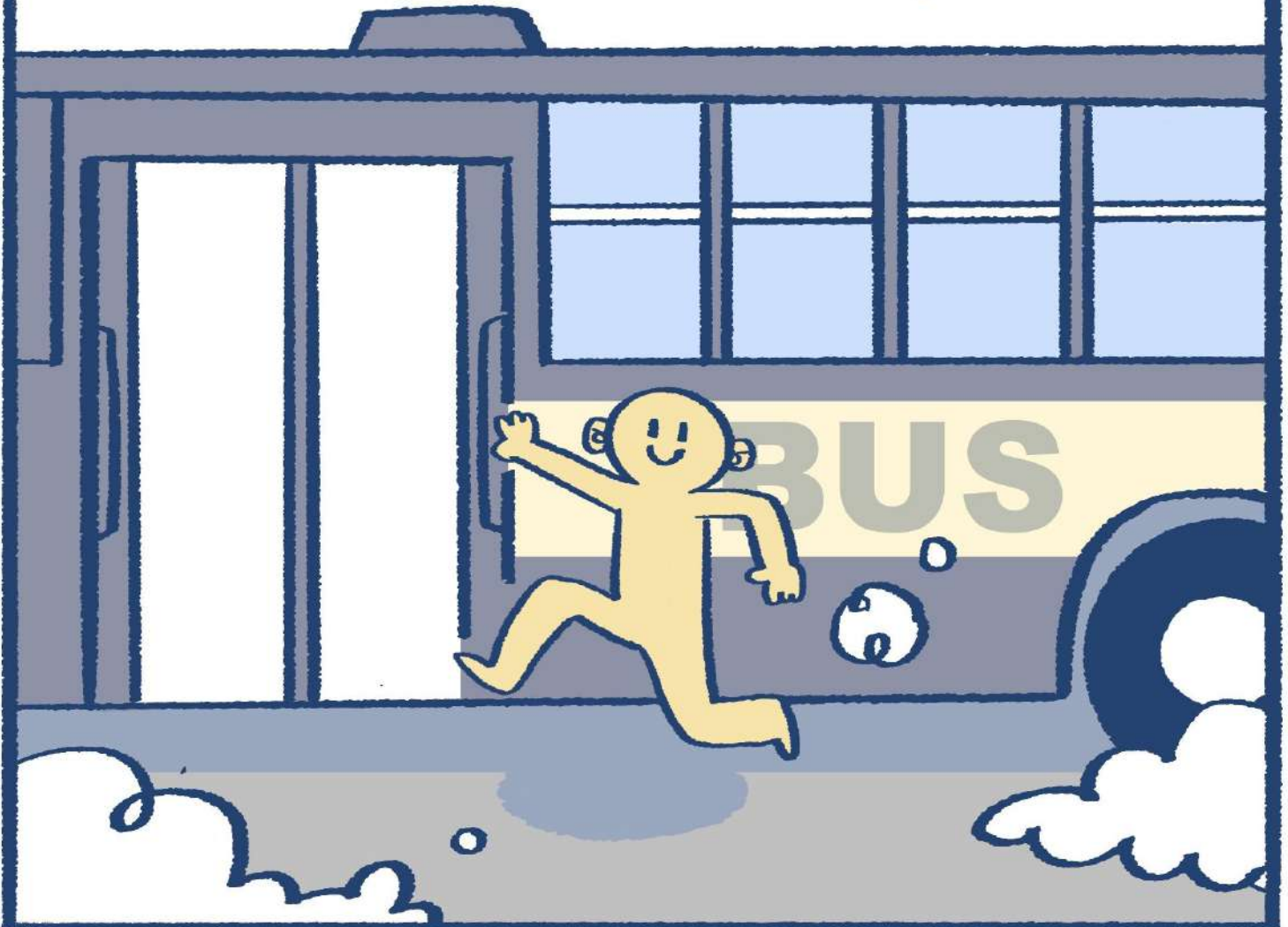

it's ok. We can dodge.

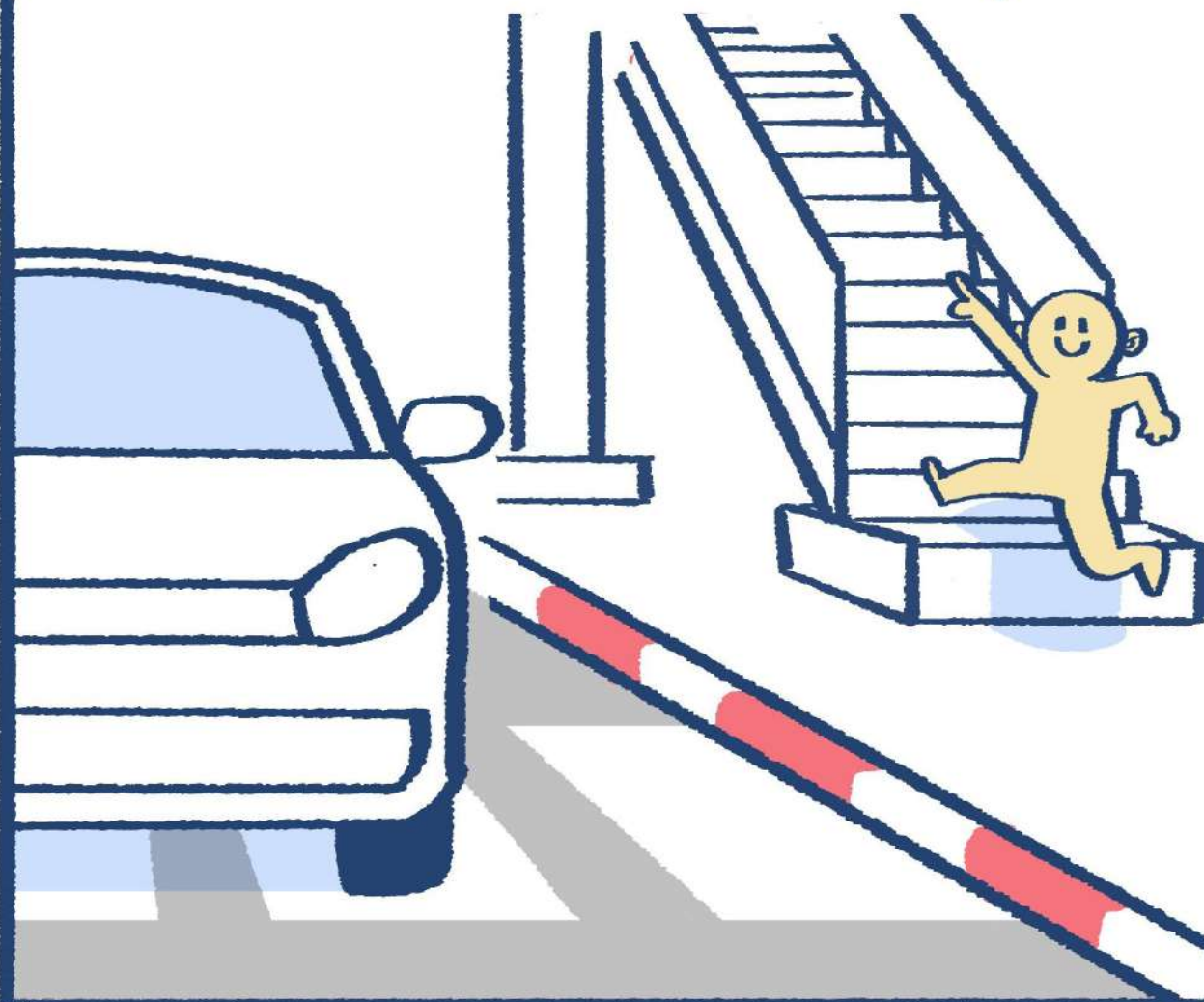


Outdated public bus

it's ok. We will walk faster to get on.



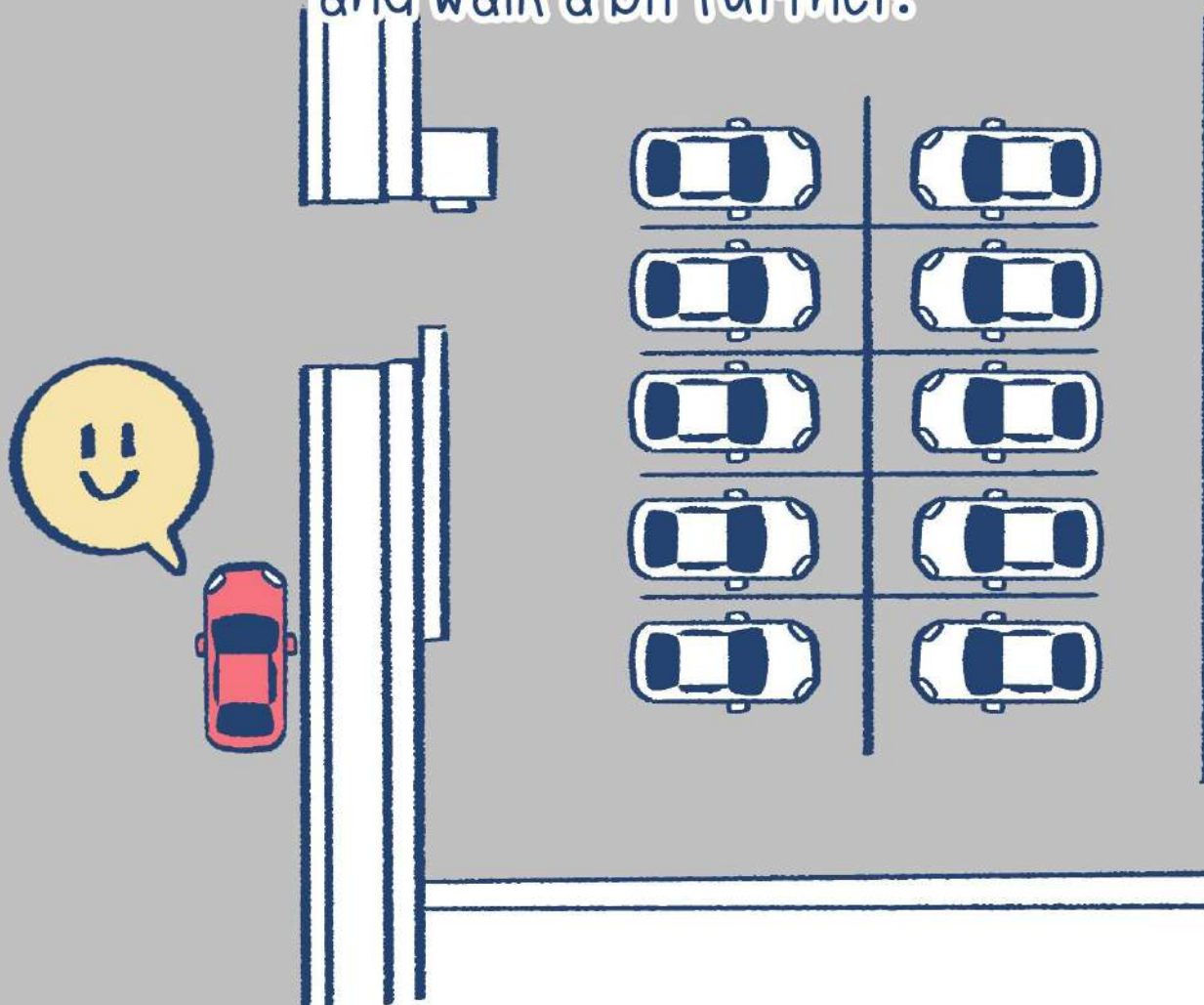


No signal light at the crosswalk,
